

# VIDEO REMODEL



## Introduction

It's a well known fact that technology advances quickly. Our current video capture/broadcast system is almost 10 years old — it is outdated, cumbersome to operate, and limited in features. A new system will improve picture quality, ensure more stable live broadcasts over the Internet, and increase our ability to use the Internet and our archived sermons as outreach tools locally and internationally. In addition, it will be significantly more user-friendly for staff and volunteers to operate and increase our ability to facilitate additional media components into our main services and various events we host. The upgrade has been broken down into three phases.

## Phase 1: \$40,500

- **Video Switching:** The computer backbone for the system — it keeps the video data captured in the same format beginning to end.
- **Video Capture:** Hardware for digital capture of the video signal, dramatically improves capture quality.
- **Web Streaming:** Hardware for streaming live services — produces reliable, consistent stream for live broadcasting.

## Phase 2: \$54,500

- **HD (High Definition) Video Camera:** captures video in HD quality.
- **Supplemental lighting:** Quality lighting is critical for quality video capture and streaming.
- **Presentation Switcher:** Hardware that allows us to seamlessly send different types of media to the projectors.

## Phase 3: \$64,500

- **Alternative Angle Camera Upgrades:** For quality video, it is ideal to have more than one camera angle. This upgrade would allow for all video captured in both the Worship Center and Family Center to be in HD quality.
- **Worship Center Projector Upgrade:** Replaces the current projectors in the Worship Center with HD projectors.

## How Will the Upgrade Be Paid For?
